*Port of Setúbal:
Containers hit 2010 record three months
before the end of the year*



The Port of Setúbal Multipurpose Terminal Zone 2, concessioned to Sadoport, hit the absolute record of 2010 in the container handling, as achieved, from January to September of 2011, 50 048 TEU, surpassing in 6,5% the previous annual maximum, of 50 744 TEU, three months before the end of the year. Just in September of 2011, were handled 11 052 TEU, a growth of 161,5%, in comparison with the 4 227 TEU of the same month, in 2010.

The raise of the containerized cargo which has been noticed through 2011, shows vitality awarded with the increasing interest by the ship owners that call Setúbal, such as Maersk and Tarros Line, which recently improved their offer in the regular lines.

Remind that the Port of Setúbal is regularly called by container lines of Portline, to Africa and Europe; of Great White Fleet, to America; of Seatrade, to Europe and America; of WEC Lines, to Europe; of Eurocondor, to Africa and Europe, of Safmarine, to Africa and Europe; of Tarros Line, to Europe, Africa and Middle East; and of Maersk Lines, to Europe, Mediterranean and Africa.
